With some 1,507 acres (610 hectares) of parks, five of which have been awarded Green Flag status, there are plenty of places to relax and unwind.

Venture further into the countryside and explore beautiful villages such as Pleshey with its castle mound, Stock with its windmill or the quiet appeal of Great Waltham and Writtle. If nature is your thing, Hanningfield Reservoir Visitor Centre is well worth a visit, as is Lingwood Common, Blake's Wood and Galleywood Common. You could even go on an organised Wildlife Walk with Chelmsford Museum's Keeper of Natural History.

Situated on the River Can and the River Chelmer, there are plenty of opportunities to enjoy the beautiful countryside from the water. There is also an abundance of angling locations, including fishing lakes and Hanningfield Reservoir.

Whether you prefer to explore the area on two feet or two wheels, there is an abundance of cycleways and footpaths, including parts of the Essex Way, to discover. Chelmsford also has a huge variety of sports clubs, including angling, athletics, boxing, canoeing, martial arts, roller-skating and sailing.

In the surrounding countryside and villages, there are plenty of other activities to keep you on the go, including kayaking at Paper Mill Lock, horse-riding, hiking, clay-pigeon shooting and cycling. The town centre hosts many exciting events during the year. Highlights include ESSEXstreetdiversions (a free weekend of international street theatre), The Twilight Spectacle (a large-scale outdoor evening performance), and the Christmas lights switch-on in November.

For music lovers, there is something to suit all tastes, whether it be enjoying a classical music recital in the ornate surroundings of Hylands House, or catching the hottest rock, pop and soul acts from around the world at the annual V Festival in Hylands Park. It is 10 miles northeast of Chelmsford and 15 miles west of Colchester on the River Blackwater, A120 road and a branch of the Great Eastern Main Line.

Braintree has grown contiguous with several surrounding settlements: Braintree proper lies to the south of Stane Street,

and Bocking lies to the north. The two together can be referred to as Braintree and Bocking, although many people refer to them together as "Braintree"
